Presentation(s)	<ul> <li>The Power of Community Assets</li> <li>Dr. Richard Lewanczuk, Senior Medical Director, Health System Integration, Alberta Health Services</li> <li>About 80% of our health is determined by social determinants of health (factors outside of the healthcare system that contribute to wellness).</li> <li>Enhancing care in the community is about keeping people as healthy, well and independent as they can be in their homes and communities.</li> <li>Identifying and coordinating the various resources available for health and wellness at a community level will benefit all Albertans and their communities.</li> <li>Discussion focused on wellness as a factor of health and what community resources are available to support wellness outside the formal healthcare system.</li> </ul>
