

SUMMARY OF THE DECISION OF THE OFFICIAL ADMINISTRATOR

The Audit and Finance Advisory Committee (the "**Committee**"), which is a governance advisory committee of the Official Administrator of Alberta Health Services ("**AHS**") (the "**Official Administrator**"), met on March 19, 2014 to discuss key issues regarding the below items. RESOLUTION OF THE OFFICIAL ADMINISTRATOR OF ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES

1. [AFAC14-28] 2014/15 Interim Budget

AHS requires approval for expenditures commencing April 1, 2014 pending final approval of the 2014-15 budget which is currently being reviewed. This interim budget for the first quarter of 2014-15 has a maximum operating expenditure of \$3,330 million and a maximum capital expenditure of \$100 million. This interim budget, which is similar to one quarter of the 2013-14 annual budget, allow operations to continue until the full year budget is approved.

WHEREAS this Resolution is enacted pursuant to Section 11(2)(a) of the *Regional Health Authorities Act* (Alberta) and the Order of the Minister of Health of Alberta dated September 10, 2013, appointing Dr. John Cowell as the Official Administrator of AHS;

AND WHEREAS the AHS 2014/15 operating and capital budgets will not be finalized by April 1, 2014;

AND WHEREAS AHS requires approval for 2014/15 expenditures based on an interim budget, pending final review and approval of the 2014/15 budget;

AND WHEREAS a roll forward of the 2013/14 budget as an interim measure will allow portfolios within AHS to continue with current operations;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The AHS interim budget consisting of a roll forward of the 2013/14 budget with a maximum operating expenditure of \$3,330 million and a maximum capital expenditure of \$100 million between April 1 and June 30, 2014, pending finalization of the 2014/15 operating and capital budgets, is hereby approved.

2. Management of AHS is hereby authorized to take all such other action as management considers necessary or advisable in order to give full effect to the foregoing.
