RESOLUTION OF THE OFFICIAL ADMINISTRATOR OF ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES

1. [OA14-18] Appointment of Health Advisory Council Members

There are 12 Health Advisory Councils in Alberta, established in 2009 under the *Regional Health Authorities Act*. Councils work to engage Albertans living in communities throughout the province in dialogue about local health services and provide feedback gathered about what is working well and suggest areas for improvement to AHS.

WHEREAS this Resolution is enacted pursuant to Section 11(2)(a) of the Regional Health Authorities Act (Alberta) and the Order of the Minister of Health of Alberta dated September 10, 2013, appointing Dr. John Cowell as the Official Administrator of AHS (the "Official Administrator");

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 7.3(b) of the Amended Bylaw for AHS Establishing Health Advisory Councils, members of the health advisory councils are appointed by the relevant regional health authority;
