Dr. Scott-Douglas is the Senior Medical Director of the Alberta Health Services Kidney Health Strategic Clinical Network and the Medical Director of the Southern Alberta Renal Program. Within the University of Calgary he is a Clinical Associate Professor and Head of the Division of Nephrology.

Dr. Scott-Douglas is a clinical Nephrologist who has an interest in clinical research and administration. He completed an undergraduate degree at the University of Calgary in Animal Biology and subsequently went on to obtain a PhD in Cardiovascular Physiology and a post-doctoral fellowship from the Alberta Heritage Foundation for Medical Research.

His research interests relate to the role of cardiovascular disease in kidney disease as well as clinical trials investigating hemodialysis vascular access, anemia management and renal metabolic bone disease.

He is significantly involved in administration of kidney care in Alberta and in the process of evaluation of patient care processes and quality improvement initiatives of care delivery.

He is a member of the Alberta Kidney Disease Network and in collaboration has received over \$2 million in research funding from the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Canada, the Kidney Foundation of Canada, National Institute of Health (NIH) and the pharmaceutical industry.



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
