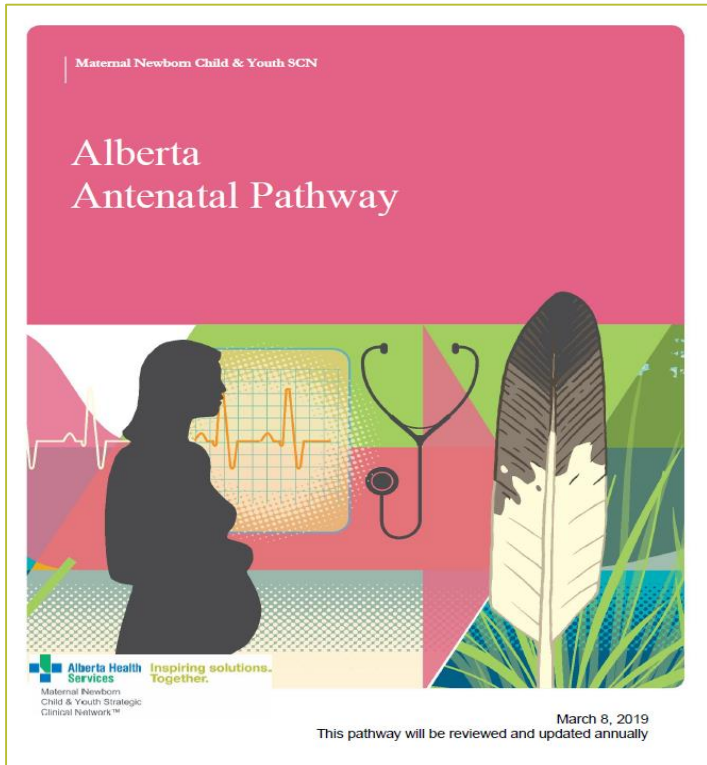

Annually, there are 55,000 births in Alberta. Some pregnancy and birth risks identified include:

29%	Cesarean Section	11%	Neonatal Intensive Care Unit admission
10%	Diabetes	10%	Pre-pregnancy weight > 91 kg
7%	Hypertension	4%	Postpartum hemorrhage
