Tobacco-like products include, but are not limited to, e-cigarettes or other electronic smoking/vaping products, hookah, marijuana that is administered by smoking or vaporizing, and any other substance that is smoked or vaped, but does not include any regulated Nicotine Replacement Therapy (NRT) products that are consumed in a manner similar to a tobacco product (e.g. an inhaler).
