

Public Parking Rates

Rates apply 24 hours per day, and are in effect for all public parkers, including those with provincially issued placards for persons with disabilities. Public parking is GST exempt.

Current rates

Hourly: \$1.00 per half hour or portion thereof

Daily: \$7.50 for 24 hours

Effective April 1st, 2024

Hourly: \$1.25 per half hour or portion thereof

Daily: \$8.00 for 24 hours

Parking Payment Options

PAY BY PHONE



Parking payment can be made using a smart phone. Download the AHS Parking app (search **AHS Parking** on the Android or Apple IOS app store) and use **zone 6494.** Parking can be extended using the app. A valid credit card is required.

PAYSTATIONS



Paystations accept Canadian coins (5¢, 10¢, 25¢, \$1, \$2) or credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express). Maximum 28 Canadian coins per transaction, no pennies. Paystations provide no change.

CHANGE MACHINES



Change machines accept Canadian bills (\$5, \$10, \$20) and are located beside the Parking Office and inside the Emergency entrance lobby.

WEEKLY/MONTHLY PASSES

Current rates

Weekly: \$28.50 **Monthly:** \$38.00

Effective April 1st, 2024

Weekly: \$30.00 **Monthly:** \$40.00

Weekly and monthly passes are available for purchase at the Parking Office, with a signed authorization form from thenursing unit or social worker.

Vehicle and Height Restrictions

Height restrictions: Covered portion of the main lot: 2.20 meters (7 ft. 4 in.)



Accessible Parking Locations

Main Public Lot: Accessible parking stalls are located at the row closest to the main entrance.

Cancer Clinic Lot: Accessible parking stalls are located close to the clinic entrance.

Emergency Lot: Accessible parking stalls are located close to the emergency entrance.

Display of valid government-issued parking placard for persons with disability required. Parking rates apply.
