Where do I park?



Parking Lots

- Public parking is available on the main level.
 Pay stations are located in the lobby and by the Emergency Department entrance.
- You will need to remember your license plate to pay for parking. Machine takes credit cards or coins. No change is provided - use exact change.

Drop Off and Pick Up

There is a drop off and pickup area at the main entrance.

Checking in for your first appointment



Check in with reception in the waiting room of the **Ambulatory Care Department**, located to the left of the elevators. The chemotherapy unit is within the Ambulatory Care Department.

When you check in, we will give you a copy of the **Newly Diagnosed with Cancer** book, if you don't already have one.

What do I need to bring with me?

Fort McMurray Schedule



We schedule patient assessments on Mondays and Wednesdays, with a cancer doctor and nurse.

Treatment days are Tuesday–Friday. We are closed on weekends and statutory holidays.

Can I bring electronics?



Yes, you may bring your cell phone, laptop, tablet or other devices. Please be respectful and:

- Put your phone on vibrate
- Bring earphones for entertainment devices
- Network: Healthspot (no password required)

Individual tv's are located in the clinic rooms.



It's a good idea to bring something to read or do while you wait for your appointments.

Where do I get my prescriptions filled?



Fill your prescriptions at your local pharmacy before your appointment at the cancer centre (unless you have been given other instructions by your cancer care team).



Where can I get my bloodwork drawn?



At the hospital lab on the main floor.

We will give you an appointment date and time to have your bloodwork completed before your treatment. The lab will have a copy of the requisition form on file already.
