At the Hand Hygiene Reviewer Forum, topics are discussed that are important to all reviewers. This document summarizes the key messages discussed with reviewers to ensure reliable and representative data on hand hygiene. It is important to familiarize yourself with key messages so you stay informed of changes to the hand hygiene review process.

Topic	Summary
Ways to Engage Your Team	Conducting hand hygiene reviews is an open and transparent process. Announce your presence and explain your role in conducting reviews.
	 Are staff curious about the review process? Feel free to pause reviews to show data collection to staff. Explain how the 4-moments are collected and reinforce the anonymity of data collection!
	Kindness and humor are amazing tools when conducting reviews!
	It's okay to have fun with hand hygiene. Ask your manager if there is a space for you to make a creative board to share compliance data and hand hygiene tips!
