	If you are a staff member of a contracted service provider that is active in the AHS Clean Hands System, you can disregard this messaging for now. You will receive separate messaging in the early in 2024 closer to launch.
Connect Care Devices	It's important to note how Connect Care devices are being used and determine if they are considered patient environment or healthcare environment so you can record the hand hygiene observations correctly. The Hand hygiene and Connect Care Devices Information Sheet provides an overview of proper use of Connect Care devices during patient interactions. Scenarios of an admission where the Workstation on Wheels was considered patient environment was reviewed. The same scenario was reviewed where the Workstation on Wheels was part of the healthcare environment. Differences were discussed. Another scenario regarding medication delivery with a rover was reviewed and discussed.
