Globally, as of 6:07pm CEST, 21 October 2021, there have been 241,886,635 confirmed cases of COVID-19, including 4,919,755 deaths, reported to WHO. As of 21 October 2021, a total of 6,655,399,359 vaccine doses have been administered.
