Course Outline

Session 1: Introduction + Understanding the Problem

Introduction into design thinking, and jumping into understanding users experience, their challenges and systemic thinking. Teams will learn how to better understand the challenge from the end user's perspective, how to we map this new data and create elements to share this information with leaders and teams.

Session 2: Defining the Challenge

How do we pick the right place to put our energy? In this session we will learn about leverage points and where to focus for greatest impact. The teams will learn how to reframe these problems and turn them into opportunities, and then pick the one they want to focus on, and that the user needs them to focus on.

Session 3: Creativity in Complexity

Creativity will help us unlock new ways of working. Using analogous thinking and creative tools, we can generate new solutions to old challenges. Teams will learn tools to problem solve in creative ways and ensure these creations meet the needs of the users they are designing for. They will narrow down to a single idea what they believe will improve the user's experience or outcomes.

Session 4: Prototyping and Validation

With an idea on mind, how do we create something that our users can interact with? In this session, teams will be provided with strategies on how to put their idea into the hands of their users. They will also build out evaluation plans to understand if their solution is meeting the needs of their users and tackles the challenge they selected.
