## Blue-green algae advisory lifted for Baptiste Lake (Athabasca)

ATHABASCA – Alberta Health Services has lifted the blue-green algae advisory for Baptiste Lake. Monitoring of the lake water has indicated that it is again safe to swim, wade, and consume fish caught from Baptiste Lake.

Blue-green algae signage, previously posted around the lake, has been removed.
