

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

RE: The food establishment located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:

OEB Breakfast

110 - 2207 4 Street SW

WHEREAS I, an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The water temperature at the dish level during the sanitizing cycle for the high temperature kitchen dishwasher measured between 59-60 degrees after running multiple cycles. The dishwasher was actively being used to wash dishes.
- b. A record of the dishwasher being tested could not be produced.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. The water temperature at the dish level during the sanitizing cycle for the high temperature kitchen dishwasher measured between 59-60 degrees after running multiple cycles. The dishwasher was actively being used to wash dishes. The dishwasher was actively being used to wash dishes. This contravenes section 28(2) of the Food Regulation, AR 31/2006 which states that: A commercial food establishment, all equipment and utensils in it and all surfaces in it with which food comes into contact must be maintained in a sanitary condition and, without limiting the foregoing, must be washed and sanitized in a manner that removes contamination.
- b. A record of the dishwasher being tested could not be produced. This contravenes section 29(1) of the Food Regulation, AR 31/2006 which states that: A commercial food establishment must have written procedures designed to ensure its safe and sanitary operation and maintenance.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Repair, service, or replace the dishwasher. Ensure the temperature of water at the dish level during the sanitizing cycle measures greater than 71 degrees Celsius.
 - b. Maintain records showing dishwasher sanitizing cycle monitoring.
 - c. Rewash all dishes/utensils.
- 2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by **July 29, 2024**.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
