

## ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER FOR REPAIR

**RE:** Those housing premises located in Edmonton, Alberta and municipally described as:

5607 118 Avenue Suite 104 NW (Block 1, Plan 0821285)

WHEREAS I, an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. There was one burner on the stove that was not functioning.
- b. There was no smoke alarm installed on the ceiling in the hallway outside the bedrooms.
- c. Dead cockroaches were seen throughout the suite and the occupant stated he was also dealing a bedbug infestation.
- d. The window lock was missing for the kitchen window.

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Housing Regulation, Alberta Regulation 173/99, the Minimum Housing and Health Standard exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Item (a) is in contravention of section IV(14)(a)(i) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: Every housing premises shall be provided with a food preparation area, which includes: a stove and a refrigerator that are maintained in a safe and proper operating condition.
- b. Item (b) is in contravention of section IV(12) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: Smoke alarms within dwellings shall be installed between each sleeping area and the remainder of the suite and, where hallways serve the sleeping areas; the smoke alarms shall be installed within the hallway.
- c. Item (c) is in contravention of section V(16)(a)(i, ii) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: All situations requiring the application of pesticides shall be conducted in accordance with the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act and regulation; and whenever a pesticide is applied in a dwelling, the occupant shall be notified in accordance with the latest edition of the Environmental Code of Practice for Pesticides published by Alberta Environmental Protection.

d. Item (d) is in contravention of section III(3)(a) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: Exterior windows and doors shall be capable of being secured.

## NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the Owner undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
  - a. Install a smoke alarm on the ceiling in the hallway outside the bedrooms.
  - b. Repair or replace the stove. Ensure that the stove is a safe working condition
  - c. Hire a certified pest control company to conduct pest control treatments for the cockroach and fruit fly infestation. Copies of the pest control reports must be provided to Environmental Public Health for verification
  - d. Install a functioning window lock for the kitchen window. Ensure that all window are capable of being secured
- 2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by December 1, 2022.
- 3. If this premises becomes vacant it is to remain vacant until all the above repairs have been completed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
