

## ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER CLOSED FOR TENANT ACCOMMODATION PURPOSES ORDER TO VACATE

**To:** Bannatyne Asset Management Inc

(The Owner(s))

Greystone Residential Management Corp.

(Property Managers)

**And To:** All Occupant(s) of the following Housing premises:

**RE:** Those housing premises located in Edmonton, Alberta and municipally described as:

9115 106A Avenue Suite 201 (Lot 5, Block F, Plan 1620288)

WHEREAS I, an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. A huge cockroach infestation, live cockroaches in various stages of development seen crawling on walls, floors and on furniture.
- b. Unsanitary conditions throughout the suite. The suite was extremely cluttered. The kitchen and the living room could not be accessed as the entire flooring was littered with various items. There was only a small pathway from the front suite entrance down the hallway to the bedroom and the washroom.

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act, Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation Alberta Regulations 243/2003 and the Housing Regulation, Alberta Regulation 173/99, and the Minimum Housing and Health Standards exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Item [a] is in contravention of, section V(16)(a) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: The owner shall ensure that the housing premises are free of insect and rodent infestations.
- b. Item [b] is in contravention of, section 2(1) of the Nuisance and General Sanitation and Regulations states that: No person shall create, commit or maintain a nuisance that might become injurious or dangerous to the public health or that might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease is deemed to have created, committed or maintained a nuisance.

**AND WHEREAS**, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed for Tenant Accommodation Purposes**.

## NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the occupants vacate the above noted premises on or before April 15, 2022.
- 2. That the Owner undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
  - a. Once the unit has been vacated the unit must be cleaned
  - The clean unit and surrounding units must be treating using a professional licensed pest control operator for cockroaches. Treatment must continue until the cockroach infestation has been irradicated
- 3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain closed for tenant accommodation purposes.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
