

## ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

To: Ann Myers

**And To:** Eldon Myers and All Occupants of the following Housing premises:

**RE:** Those housing premises located in Lethbridge, Alberta and municipally described as:

1823 1 Avenue N - Garage

WHEREAS I, an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The garage is being used as a living quarters. There are no utility services to this building.
- b. The area surrounding the garage is full of garbage and personal belongings strewn about.

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation AR 243/2003 s1 exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. The garage is being used as a living quarters. There are no utility services to this building. This is in contravention of Section 2(1) and Section 2(2)(a) of the Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation AR243/2003 which reads: "No person shall create, commit or maintain a nuisance. Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), a person who creates, commits or maintains any premises in a condition that is or might become injurious or dangerous to the public health or that might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease is deemed to have created, committed or maintained a nuisance."
- b. The area surrounding the garage is full of garbage and personal belongings strewn about. This is in contravention of Section 2(1) and Section 2(2)(a) of the Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation AR243/2003 which reads: "No person shall create, commit or maintain a nuisance. Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), a person who creates, commits or maintains any premises in a condition that is or might become injurious or dangerous to the public health or that might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease is deemed to have created, committed or maintained a nuisance."

**AND WHEREAS**, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Unfit for Human Habitation**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the occupants vacate the above noted premises on or before September 16, 2019.
- 2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
  - a. Secure property to prevent entry of anyone other than the home owner (eg. Install locks on all doors).
  - b. Remove garbage and all of the occupants belongings from the backyard.
- 3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain vacant and secure from unauthorized entry.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
