

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

- To: Dan Remfert
- **RE:** Those housing premises located in Lethbridge, Alberta and municipally described as: The Coalbanks Inn - 312 5 Street S

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

a. Major bedbug infestation throughout the entire building.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Housing Regulation, Alberta Regulation 173/99, and the Minimum Housing and Health Standards exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

Major bedbug infestation throughout the entire building which is in contravention of section V(16)(a) of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards which states that: The owner shall ensure that the housing premises are free of insect and rodent infestations.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

- 1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Contract a professional pest control company for treatment of the entire building to get control of the current infestation. All recommendations and directions must be implemented and followed, as outlined by the pest control company.
 - b. To prevent future pest infestations, a professional pest control company is required to be contracted for ongoing pest monitoring and treatment for early identification and treatment.
- 2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by June 14, 2023.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
