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Alberta Health Services	Dr. Aaron Low, South Zone Medical Director, shared the following update:
Zone Update	<ul> <li>Refocusing the healthcare system: Refocusing health care in Alberta   Alberta.ca</li> <li>On November 8, the Government of Alberta (GOA) announced plans to refocus the healthcare system. These plans include goals to improve patient care and service delivery and to empower healthcare workers. These changes will focus on the priority sectors of primary care, acute care, continuing care and mental health and addiction.</li> <li>Connect Care launch eight will take place in South Zone on May 4, 2024, and launch nine is set for November 2, 2024.</li> <li>AHS is in a deficit and south zone leadership is working to end the fiscal year in a more positive place.</li> <li>Anesthesiologists, emergency physicians and neurology are a recruitment priority.</li> <li>Dr. Aaron Low also provided a written report that was included in the meeting package, that included an update on physician recruitment in the South Zone, West:         <ul> <li>There are several positions being recruited for and fifty active postings in the areas of: addiction and mental health, anesthesia, diagnostic imagining, family, emergency and rural medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, senior's health, and surgery.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
