The Palliser Triangle Health Advisory Council area stretches from Oyen in the north to Bassano in the west, continuing eastward to the Saskatchewan border and southward to Bow Island and the United States border. Communities within the area include Bassano, Oyen, Brooks, Redcliff, Medicine Hat, Bow Island, Seven Persons, Irvine and Foremost.



### Accomplishments

- Participated in South Zone Operational Plan Steering Committee, in Addiction and Mental Health Provincial Advisory Council and the Continuing Care Quality Committee.
- Partnered with AHS to host a [Community Conversation](#) in Medicine Hat (2019). Stakeholders engaged in discussion about wellness, prevention and community care as well as opportunities for future partnerships.
- Provided feedback to AHS on COVID-19 vaccine rollout, Emergency Medical Services (EMS), facility-based continuing care, influenza campaign and cardiac service planning.

### Our role and objectives

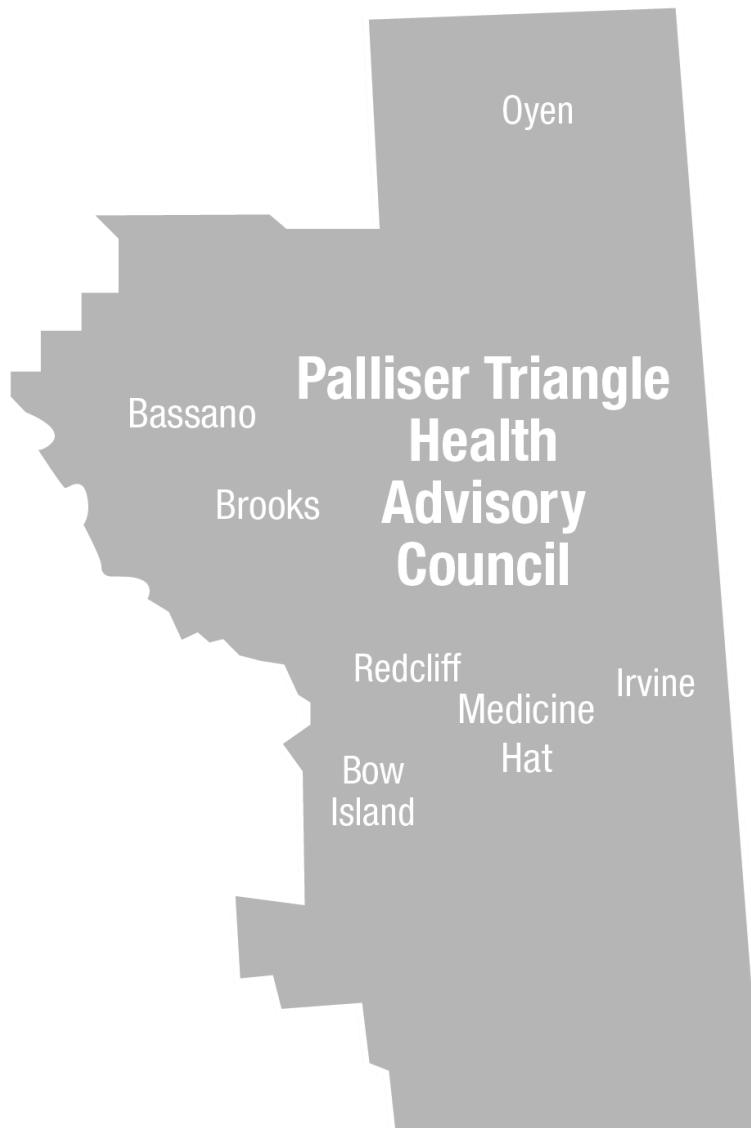
Everything we do is about improving the health and wellness of Albertans, no matter what part of the province they live in. We:
