Topic	Commitment
Seniors Care	<p>Wood Buffalo Health Advisory Council (WBHAC) has identified barriers for senior's receiving the care they need, including limited local services, lack of home supports (e.g., home care; rehabilitation) and travel/ distance. Council commits to increase its awareness of available senior's resources and supports by inviting AHS (and community groups, as applicable) to present at its Council meetings. Council will invite the public and members will share information within their networks.</p>
Health Professional Workforce	<p>WBHAC seeks to understand and build awareness about health profession staffing in the HAC area. It has identified mental health practitioners and family physicians as areas of need.
