Key Message

- Effective December 18, 2025, External Send Out (ESO) test results will appear in the appropriate discipline folder in Netcare that the test is associated with.
- Miscellaneous tests will continue to file in the “Other” Netcare folder.

Background

- ESO test results come from any test not performed by Alberta Precision Laboratories

- Previously, many ESO test results only appeared in the “Other” folder. This made it difficult for clinicians to find these results. The results also did not display with other comparable results that were tested by APL.

How this will impact you

- Be aware that new and historical ESO test results in Netcare will now appear in the appropriate discipline specific folder.
 - Exception: Miscellaneous test results will still appear in the “Other” folder.
