- A **NEW** provincial Colposcopy Pathology Requisition #22272 (2025-12) has been developed and is now available.
- All legacy/zone requisitions should be discarded and replaced with the new provincial form.
- Colposcopy samples and requests must be submitted in accordance with the following laboratory policy:

How this will impact you

For community sites/clinics that do not have access to Connect Care
NEW – Provincial Colposcopy Pathology Requisition #22272 (2025-12): Colposcopy Pathology Requisition
For acute care sites with access to Connect Care
Order colposcopy testing/consultation through designated Connect Care ordering process.

Action Required

- Discard/archive existing copies of the following requisition:

- For sites that do not have access to Connect Care: obtain the new APL Provincial Colposcopy Pathology Requisition **#22272 (2025-12)** from the APL website [Requisitions | Alberta Precision Laboratories](#)
- For sites that have access to Connect Care: order colposcopy testing/consultation through designated ordering routine.
