- There is a current delay in test result reporting for Extractable Nuclear Antigen Antibodies (ENA), Anti-Neutrophil Cytoplasmic Antibody, Anti-MPO, Anti-PR3, Anti-Glomerular Basement Membrane (GBM), Anti-Cardiolipin, and Anti-Beta2 Glycoprotein due to an instrument downtime in the Special Chemistry Lab at the University of Alberta Hospital.
